We ate, played cards, watched tv, laughed, and stressed together. The first Tuesday after we moved the shelter to the Presbyterian Church I actually felt like something was missing. I was so used to being greeted by our guests and volunteers each day that there was a little emptiness in my heart as I locked up the church empty and dark.

It was a blessing to see so much life within the church walls as we did what Jesus calls us to do.

STEPHEN MINISTRY Training Update

Our Stephen Ministers have already completed their first 4 weeks of training! They have explored the Christ-centered foundation of Stephen Ministry, developed an understanding of the role of feelings in ministering effectively to others, and enhanced their active listening skills.

Here is an update on what they will be learning this month.

- Distinctively Christian Caregiving
- Assertiveness: Relating Gently and Firmly
- Process versus Results in Caregiving

An important resource for this months' training is *Speaking* the *Truth in Love: How to Be an Assertive Christian* by Ruth Koch and Kenneth Haugk.

STEPHEN MINISTRY: The Role of the Pastor

The role of the Pastor is unique and vital to the success of any Stephen Ministry program. The reasons for this are varied:

- 1. The Pastor, more than any other person in the congregation, has knowledge of all that is going on in the lives of her flock. People trust her with information others know nothing about. So, she knows who may be in need of a Stephen Minister.
- 2. The Pastor also knows the nature of the problem, and the strengths of the Stephen Ministers, so she knows which Minister would be likely to be a good match.
- 3. The Pastor also is trusted by members of the congregation, as so they are more willing to agree when she strongly suggests that a Stephen Minister would be advisable for them.
- 4. The Pastor is also able to support any of the Stephen Ministers as their Pastor.

Pastor Dana has completed training as a Stephen Leader in January. She is already a great asset to the Stephen Ministry at Immanuel.
