Friends in Christ,

This is a special month in the church. It's the month we end our Lenten journey and proclaim loudly together, "Christ is Risen, Indeed! Alleluia!" It is also famously said, "It's Friday but Sunday is coming!" As Easter people, Lent is a time we anxiously await the celebration of the resurrection. However, knowing the gift of the resurrection we experience the joy of Easter morning with a different mind and heart when we journey through the suffering and pain.

There is no question that each of us are very familiar with suffering and pain. It is something we experience. It is something that God experiences with us. Not just on the cross over 2,000 years ago – but in every breath of grief, addiction, depression, loneliness, oppression, and illness that we breathe.

I invite each of you to join me this Holy week. We gather as a community for the holy triduum (google it) so that we know we are not alone in suffering. We gather to remember. We gather to hear God's Word. We gather to give thanks. It is in this gathering that we are transformed into the creation that God has formed us to be.

**Palm Sunday:** We will lift our palms in celebration to a king who is not of this world as we sing Hosanna and journey to the cross.

**Maundy Thursday:** We begin with the washing of the feet, prayer, and song. Then we remember the last supper and join with the first Christians in what was known as an "agape meal" or "love feast." They shared supper together (we will offer soup, salad, and sandwiches), they prayed, read Scripture, sang hymns, and shared the Eucharist. The meal begins with the breaking of the bread and blessing of the wine. And so, the entire dinner meal is part of the Eucharist. Indeed, it is the Eucharist.

**Good Friday:** We will gather for Prayer around the Cross pausing at the crucifixion.

**Sunrise Service:** We begin outside at sunrise in joyful celebration of the empty tomb and move inside to the celebration of the resurrection!

**Easter Festival Service:** We proclaim loudly, "Christ is Risen, Indeed! Alleluia!"

## From the President.....

You hear the prayer weekly during service – we pray for Stephen Ministry leaders and caregivers. You may have heard about Stephen Ministry in announcements or in the Adult Forum, too. Are you aware, though, of the impact of Stephen Ministry in our community? Perhaps not, because the work is done quietly, in personal relationships. But those quiet works are not to be confused with less impactful works. Indeed, Stephen Ministry provides care to many in our community who are facing a challenging time and are in need of extra spiritual support during a time of hurt, crisis, change, and/or loneliness, to name a few.

A year ago, I was in the middle of my training as a Stephen Minister. The training, while a commitment itself, has proven to be a powerful tool not only in my preparation as a Stephen Minister but as a human being. While I began my training a little uncertain that I was the “right person” to become a Stephen Minister, I developed a new perspective and came to understand that these skills provided a foundation through which God could use me in a caring relationship.

I want to challenge you to consider, deeply, whether Stephen Ministry might be an area of ministry to which you might be called. You needn't have all the “right answers”, you don't need to have experienced every type of crisis. A willing heart, a desire to help others, and an openness to sharing others' experiences – those will take you far. So, how about you?

A new Stephen Ministry training will begin in May. If you are interested in more information or would like to talk to someone about Stephen Ministry, you are welcome to reach out to any of the Stephen Ministry leaders, or myself. Our Stephen Ministry leaders are Chris and Fred Schuster and Gail Mitchell. I won't promise the training is easy (it's not, to be honest), but I can honestly say – it was life-changing for me. This is one of the most powerful ministries we have at Immanuel. I hope you will prayerfully consider if this might be a good fit for you.




