A Letter from Pr. Dana......

Dear friends in Christ,

As I sit writing this letter, it is a beautiful day outside. I hope that you have had a summer that has been a gift of friends, family, and enjoying the outdoors. I know many of us are thinking how quickly the summer has flown by already (it's August!) That being said, I get to announce something we have been waiting for... drum roll please....

We will begin construction on the Narthex/Welcome Center a few weeks after Labor Day and hopefully have it finished by the end of October. It will be a gift to have all the construction done by the date of our next Beer, Brats, and Hymns! We together can lift a cheer to Immanuel's next 40 years of being *Over the Hill, and Still Moving Mountains*.

We hope that the construction does not impede on our Sunday morning worship and we will be diligent to keep things safe and clear on Sunday mornings. I also thought you might like the latest update on what we have done so far with the capital campaign:

\$10,000 – gift to the community to help purchase the William Strickler Nonprofit Center

\$41, 390.89 - new projection system (which is no longer projection, but display monitors)

\$3,000 - to create a space for parents/adults to rest and connect

\$3,000 - to the youth

\$50,000 (estimate) – renovation of the welcome center/Narthex area

\$10,000 – to the capital replacement fund (for future building needs)

As the remaining pledged money becomes available, the leadership will be discerning the many requests that have been made about possible improvements (everything from updated bathrooms and fellowship hall to a new sign out front). We will see how much money is available and discern how to best utilize it.



Our four choirs will start in September after Labor Day. All choirs are always looking for new members who are dedicated to regularly attending rehearsals and singing on Sundays!! Please email me (Mernie) mbidstrup@charter.net. or catch me after the service with any questions. If Worship Wed. is cancelled for weather so are all music programs.

Children's choir - Kindergarten -5th grade ---- Hand chimes - 2nd -5th grade

Attendance at rehearsal and the Sundays that we play is required to be a part of the hand chimes.

The children's choir/ hand chime choir meets on Wednesdays at 4:00 (earlier time this year). 2nd through 5th grade hand chime practice will be from 4:00-4:45 in the Sanctuary. From 4:45-5:30 the whole group will be together in the Choir room to sing. The children's choir sings at the 9:00 service on the fourth Sunday and at the 11:00 service on the first Sunday of each month. The hand chimes will usually play at the 9:00 service on the fourth Sunday.

Bell Choir - 6th grade through high school- includes some college students

The bell choir usually meets on Wednesdays from 7:15-8:30. Rehearsals may be on other nights as needed. (Our members are not just dedicated to the bell choir but are also very involved in other church and school activities which can cause schedule changes.) The rehearsal is fast paced and fun. The choir plays on the fourth Sunday at the 9:00 service and also plays at festival services. Come and try it- I'd be happy to meet with you and give you a mini lesson before you attend a rehearsal. We'd love to see you!

Chancel Choir- all ages welcome

Chancel Choir sings a variety of familiar and new SATB music. We sing at the 9:00 service on the first and third Sunday of the month. We also sing at all festival services. (Reformation, Christmas Eve, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter) If you've ever sung in a choir or would just like to give it a try, come to our rehearsal at 6:00 on Wednesdays. We can be pretty noisy and we often talk too much (you know who you are ©) but we have fun and are a great group of people and we would love to have you join us!
