**In-Person Worship will resume OUTSIDE on Sunday, JULY 19<sup>th</sup> at 10am!!!!**

What if it rains? We will move to online worship only.

After discussing details on how we will worship outdoors here are a few of the things you can expect:

- \*We will continue to stream services online for those who choose to stay home, stay safe**
- \*Please bring a chair, or we will have folding chairs available**
- \*If you prefer to stay in your car we will have a section for drive up**
- \*Keep social distancing (no handshaking, no hugs)**
- \*Everyone must wear a mask**
- \*We will have masks available if you forget (once you wear the mask you can bring it home)**
- \*We will have printed bulletins for those who wish to have one**
- \*While outside, we will have the band distanced and singing, along with any special music Mernie produces. Only a few people singing - not congregational singing.**
- \*If you want a prayer added the same day, please communicate the name and reason for the prayer to pastor.**
- \*The offering basket will be placed on a stand**
- \*We will have communion once a month (the last Sunday of the month)**
- \*Ushers will have a check list to take attendance**

If someone who worshipped with us is diagnosed with COVID-19 they are to report that to Pastor Dana. The office will then inform those who may have come into contact with the virus. We will close in-person worship and resume online worship while we quarantine for 14 days.

A few of us were back in the area that we will be worshipping in making plans and I really was excited to not only get to see many of you, but I think it will be special to worship outside for a time. I get to move from all tech to all outside! Alleluia!! Let's put those screens away and feel that breeze! I look forward to seeing you July 19 (hoping there is no rain!!)
