This week's Bible story is
Angels Visit
from Luke 1:26-38

Jesus is God's Son *and* one of us!

Ask each other what you remember about:

- Angel
- Mary
- Joseph
- Fear
- Holy Spirit
- God

Jesus is both human and divine. This story tells us how Jesus' mom was a woman and Jesus' father was God. That makes Jesus human *and* divine at the same time!

Each time you see a nativity set, remember that the story began with an angel visiting Mary.



Ear Spark

When you hear Christmas carols this season, listen for what the angels do/say/sing and remember this angel story.

LIVE IT

For families to do together

Make angels to decorate your Christmas tree. Use paper or clay or cookie dough or whatever materials you have around. Have the angels carry small signs or banners that tell part of this story: God is with you! Name him Jesus! With God, all things are possible! Don't be afraid!
