2019 NWLM Synod Assembly



North/West Lower Michigan Synod Assembly 2019

Called to be like Living Stones in a Changing World

The 2019 Synod Assembly is May 16-18, 2019 (Thursday – Saturday) at the Comfort Inn & Suites Hotel and Conference Center in Mount Pleasant and Immanuel Lutheran Church.

Several important events will take place at this Synod Assembly including a **bishop election** (Bishop Satterlee is standing for re-election), vice president election (Sandy Schlesinger is standing for re-election), and electing synod council members and members of several important committees.

Several **special guests** will attend the Assembly. Our churchwide representative, the Rev. Wm. Chris Boerger, Secretary of the ELCA, will preside at the bishop election, give the churchwide report, preside at Eucharist Friday morning and preach at closing worship Saturday morning. **Three Bishops** from Region Six will attend. Bishop Abraham Allende (Northeast Ohio Synod) will preach at Eucharist Friday morning, Bishop Daniel Beaudoin (Northwest Ohio Synod) will offer a reflection on a call story Friday morning. Bishop Suzanne Darcy Dillahunt (Southern Ohio Synod) will offer a reflection on a call story Thursday evening.

Dakota Road, a nationally known musical group, will provide music at opening worship on Thursday AND during the "Connect, Converse, Contemplate, or Crash" portion of the assembly on Friday at 5pm, which will be held at Immanuel.

A Closing Worship Service and reception will be held at noon on Saturday at Immanuel. All are welcome to attend.

Immanuel's voting members this year include Pr. Dana, Ryan Douglas, Beth Mundwiler and Thomas Strandskov. Charlie Burke, Peggy Burke, Nicole Ferguson, Jim Hageman, Mary Hageman, Katrina Piatek-Jimenez, and Amy Powell are serving on the Synod Assembly Elections Committee. Linda Wicander is a voting member on Synod Council.

Contributing Stocks or Bonds

To contribute capital gain property such as stocks or bonds to the church, per IRS Publication 526 you can deduct the Fair Market Value of the asset on your personal tax returns - not the basis in the asset. Immanuel has a brokerage account to facilitate the transfer of these assets directly. If you are interested, please contact the church for information or assistance.

Tax Break for Contributions -people over 70 years-old

If you are over 70.5 did you know that you can give directly from your retirement account to Immanuel Lutheran Church and pay no taxes on the gift? Due to the tax changes that include a higher standard deduction and the elimination of the personal exemption, you may receive the best tax benefit if you donate directly from your retirement account.
