

A Letter from Pr. Dana.....

Friends in Christ,

Grace and peace to you! This is a big week for Immanuel! We have a lot in the works, and I am going to wet your palate with FOUR things to expect this month! Please watch your weekly emails for more specific information.

- 1. The worship ministry team and the executive team met this week to discuss returning to worship inside the building! As you may have noticed, there is a new executive order that opens up some of the restrictions. **Our goal is to celebrate Reformation inside together at 9am and 11am starting Sunday, October 25.** There will be numerous changes and restrictions including only 50 people during each service. So, you will need to make reservations before coming. Please watch for more information and kindly understand that all of the decisions about indoor worship are subject to change at any time due to COVID-19 numbers and exposure. We will of course continue to live-stream the service for those who are not comfortable with returning as of yet. We will also offer drive-thru communion on the last Sunday of the month.
- 2. In October we are also going to do something we have never done before! I will be inviting the congregation to watch a YouTube special by Rob Bell titled, "An Introduction to Joy." It is about an hour and twenty minutes long. Next week I will be recording a panel discussion on the special with a few members of the congregation. Once that is recorded, we will post on our website the link to the YouTube special, the panel discussion, and two Zoom opportunities to discuss further if you are interested.
- 3. We are in the midst of planning a drive-in movie night! It'll be October 18 at 7pm! Watch for more information soon.
- 4. Finally, we plan to host a virtual hymn sing to celebrate Reformation in style on Friday, October 23rd at 6pm. You're used to it being "Beer, Brats, and Hymns" at Hunter's Ale House. This year you'll have to provide your own beer and brats at home, but we'll bring the hymns via Zoom. If you're a hymn lover (and yes, this includes contemporary), make sure to attend because there will be no congregational singing during in-person worship in the building.

I continue to pray for you. I hope you will participate in the few things that we are offering so you may stay connected and continue to grow in your life-of-faith!


